Abstract Submission Format

- Length: Abstracts should be between 250 to 500 words.
- Format: Submissions should be in Word or PDF format.
- Content: Abstracts must clearly outline the objectives, methodology, and expected contributions of the proposed presentation.

- Notification of Acceptance: 16 June 2025
- Conference Date: 28 November 2025

All submissions will undergo a rigorous peer review process. Authors of accepted abstracts will be invited to present at the conference which provides an excellent opportunity to showcase their work. Authors will also have the chance to submit full papers for publication in the conference proceedings.
